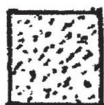
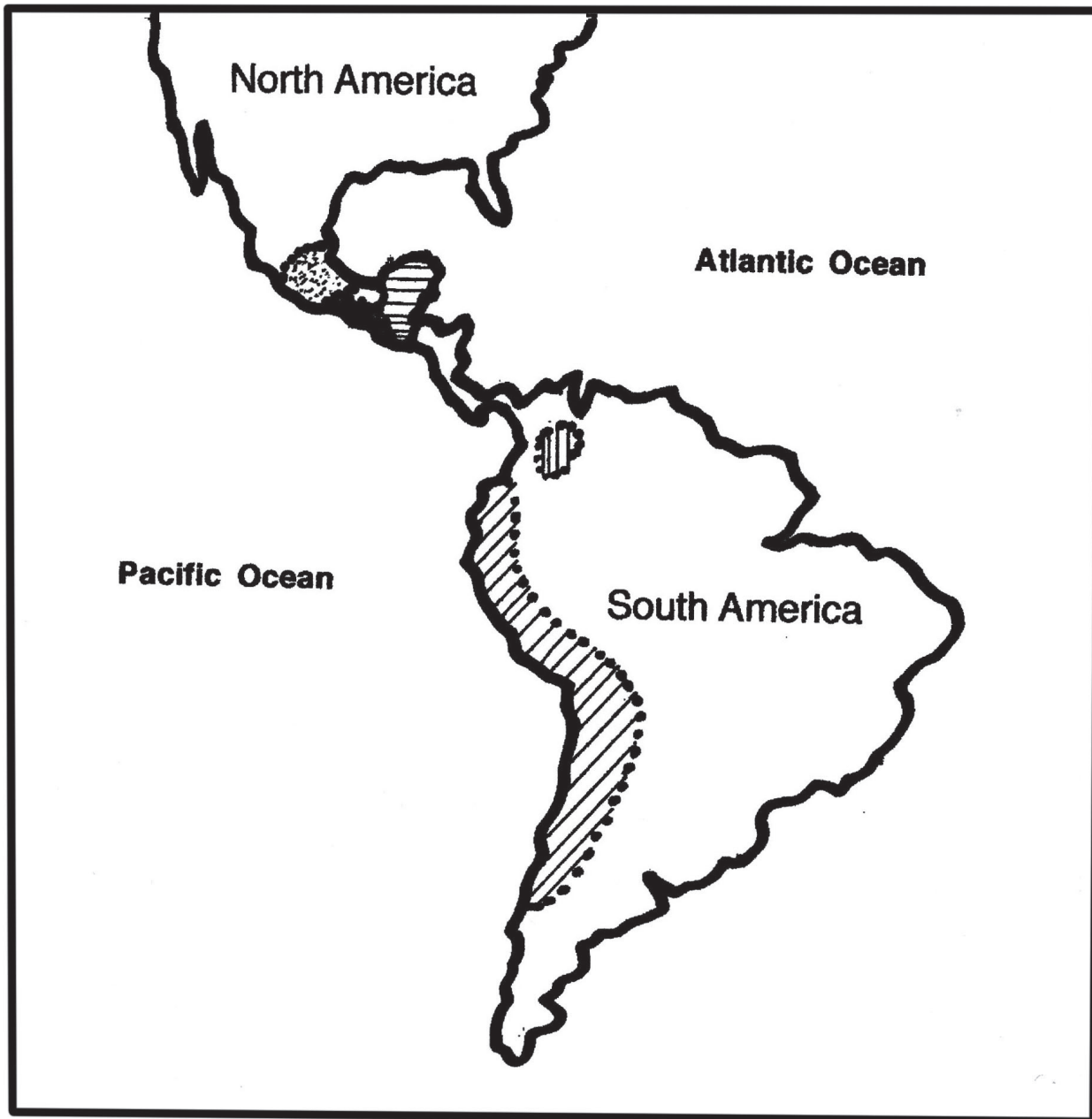
Different groups of people lived in these areas and each developed a unique civilization. Do the following:

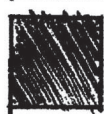
